Dear friends in Christ,  
There is a big contrast in last week's gospel and this week.  
In last week's gospel, Jesus was in the desert, alone, hungry, suffering and tempted.  
In this week's gospel, Jesus is on the mountain with his Father, the Holy Spirit, his friends, Moses, and Elijah.  
Last week, it was about following Jesus, suffering with him, not sinning.  
Though Jesus was in the form of God, Jesus learned in suffering to empty himself and after doing this, became a  
self offering gift to humanity. He is now ready to start his public mission.

This week, we are invited to experience the highs instead of the lows.  
Peter says to Jesus: "Rabbi," he said "It is wonderful for us to be here; so let us make three tents, one for you,  
**one for Moses and one for Elijah.**" Peter experienced a little taste of heaven, bliss, ecstasy for a short moment.  
This came about from the communion with the Holy Trinity and the saints represented by Moses and Elijah.  
Do you consider the greatest experience of joy, happiness, freedom, love, peace is found in holy communion with  
the Holy Trinity, all the saints, and angels?  
Let's be smart and think like St Paul: "**For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth  
comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.**" Rom 8:18.  
The suffering we suffer in temptations and doing penance, is actually the little death that kills sin and death itself,  
so the life of Jesus can live in us.

Our faith leads us to the greatest experience, glorification of our humanity, when we overcome sin and death and  
become one with Jesus, but never without the cross.

By popular demand, our parish will add St Charbel Makhlouf's statue to our surroundings and the statue will go on  
the right hand side of the grotto.

We have one Catechumen (Julia Lee) who will become a Catholic at the Easter Vigil and last week, Julia went to  
St Mary's Cathedral to partake in the Rite of Election. During the remaining week's of Lent, a period of purification  
and scrutiny, Julia will join us at a Sunday Mass, to receive the Creed, the Our Father prayer and a blessing.
